
























Algeria Map

Discovering Algeria

Algeria is a huge country of 2,300,000 km2, which is almost a continent! Algeria with its 1200 km of coastline and 6,000 km of borders along with Tunisia, Libya, Niger, Mali, Mauritania, Western Sahara, Morocco, is now a booming tourist destination. Here, everything is moving, changing, becoming something everything shows a spectacle and recreation, birth, collective creation...



Algeria is an entity, a young and dynamic state, but continues to assert the diversity that reveals also a way of life and explaining the world. The emphasis is on many sectors deemed to be essential: education, agriculture, housing...



The sandy beaches alternate with high green cliffs that cover the coastal road; that of Dahra, west between Mostaganem, Tenes and Cherchell (ancient Caesarea); in addition to Chenoua between Cherchell and Tipaza and then that of Sahel up to Algiers, in the east, there is a mountain road of Kabyle from Dellys to Bejaia, from Tichy to Jijel. Parallel to the coastline, there are tells of Atlas, followed by green area and cedar forests that provide shade and coolness in the heat of summer.






In the center, there are mountains of Ouarsenis (1985m), Kef Righa (1714m), Chréa (1510m), Titteri, the chain of Hodna and Djurdjura of nearly 3000 m.

Inlow-lying and strictly parallel to the Atlas Tells, there is Saharan Atlas of 2300 m with Ksours, Djebel Amour, Ouled Nail Mountains .










Between the two Atlas , the highlands goes on further as far as the Alfa, Sersou plateau and mainly the Aures massif or throne to 2328 m, Jebel Chelia.

Finally the Sahara, though to be flat, monotonous and empty, is however living, changing, magical. The silence, the white and ochre houses, waves of sand, space, also traces of greenery and oasis life, erg, Hammada, dunes, so many magic words to explain this world in which is the Hoggar, of more than 3000 m, dominates, and is carrying messages from civilizations thousands of years old (rock paintings and carvings ...).



The different civilizations which were in Algeria for centuries, have left traces of exceptional values in this country.



And here is the blue sky of a legendary region that continues to amaze even those who are the most jaded and make them dream.







First day: Oran

On arrival at Oran, a walk is planned then transfers to hotel, followed with dinner. The night will be spent in hotel.

Second day: Oran

There would be trip to city center and visit of seafront road, Blanca area and the museum Zabana. Excursion to Cape of Falcon through El Kebir Sea followed by dinner and night spent in the hotel.

Third day: Oran / Tlemcen

Excursion to Tlemcen. There would be visit of Mansura ruins and the minaret of 38 meters which reminds us the Koutoubia ,in addition to Tlemcen museum visit. In the afternoon, there would be visit of the big mosque of Tlemcen and further visit up to the village of El-Eubad followed by Sidi Boumedienne and madrasas tomb visit, then return to city center of Tlemcen . Dinner and night spent in the hotel.

Fourth day: Tlemcen

After breakfast, visit the waterfalls of El Ourit and continue until Beni Add caves (Ain Fezza). The after noon visit Mechouar; palace of the kingdom of Zianides and Lella Setti plateau. Back to the hotel dinner and overnight.

Fifth day: Tlemcen/ Sidi Bel-Abbes / Oran

The morning excursion to Sidi Bel - Abbes and continuation to Oran. Visit Santa Cruz and the Chapel of the Virgin, but also a glimpse of the beautiful mosque of the Pasha downtown. Installation at the hotel dinner and accommodation in Oran.


Sixth day: Departure

Transfer to the airport and assistance is provided in the departure. End of services

As a capital of western Algeria, Oran occupies a strategic position in the Western Mediterranean. Its position at the bottom of an open bay in the northern side and in the western side bounded with the steep mountain of Aidour, has made it exceptional. The city is divided between the old Spanish Arabian city, the colonial and post colonial city. The buildings feature shows a new Oran and gives resolutely to the same a contemporary modern face.

A visit to Oran entails necessarily the visit of waterfront road where we can see an overview on the port and the old town. We can see the mosque of Pasha and go back up the crowded streets around the place named 1st November before going to the museum Zabana. It is necessary to go for walk in the wood of planters and Murdjadjo where anybody can have a complete view of the city. The visitor should not forget to visit in the same time Santa Cruz Fort and the vergin marry Chapel. Before leaving Oran do not forget to visit also the Marabout of Sidi El Houari (patron of the city) to make a wish, it's a tradition.





First Day : Algiers

Reception at Algiers airport, city tour and discovery of Algiers; visit of "Bastion 23" or "Rais XVII century, Palace" edified at the end of the discovery of Notre Dame d'Afrique Cathedral overlooking the bay. Night in Algiers.

Second Day: Algiers
Discovery of the old city "Casbah", with all its streets and low houses. El Djazair recalls also the Barberousse Borthers piracy and the Ottoman Sultan suzerainty, then visit of Beaux-Arts museum that houses works of art of Flemish, Italian and French artists from the XIV and XIX century. Overnight in Algiers.

Third Day: Algiers / Cherchell / Tipaza / Algiers

Departure to Cherchell, the ancient Caesarea, built by Juba II, king of Numidia. Visit the "park of mosaic museum " the Tour will continue with the visit of Tipaza, ancient trading post, visit of the archeological park, that combines ruins and seaside nature, and where is located the Frescos Villa of Tipaza City. Finally, discovery of the Royal Mausoleum of Mauretania, overlooking the sea from the from the top of a hill and surrounded by olives trees. Retrun and obernight in Algiers.

Fourth Day: Algiers / Djamila / Sétif

Departure to Djamila, "The Beautiful" in Arabic, on the most interesting antique site in Algeria. The ruins of the roman city 'Cuicul' built under Emperor Nerva, in the first century, and is part of rugged landscape. Visit of the museum housing the objects found on the site. Sétif does not lack charm, with its places, large avenues lined with arcades and gardens. visit the National Museum. Overnight in

Fifth Day: Setif / Constantine

Departure for Constantine. Most of the old city monuments were built during the Ottoman Era, except the Great Mosque, which dates from the XIX century. View of the different bridge that spans the Rummel Gorges, beside which the city was edified. Overnight in Constantine.

Sixth Day: Constantine / Timgad / Batna
Between Constantine and Batna, the Aures
Mountains Citadel opens its doors. Stop at
Medracen and then continue the tour towards Timgad, that was founded in the year 100 under the reign of Trajan. The city is listed among the World Heritage of Unesco and is very well conserved, saved by sand and oblivition. visit the museum and the archeological site overnight in Batna.

Seventh Day: Batna / Khenchla / Tebessa

Departure to Khenchla, which is an important gateway to the Aures, Namencha plateaus, continue the visit towards Tebessa, that was founded by the Vespasien at the end of the first century. Two prestigious buildings that reflects the apogee of the city: from one side the "Arc of Caracalla" which dates from 212, the temple and the museum named "Minerve" from the other side . Overnight in Tebessa.

Eighth Day: Tebessa / Khemissa / Madaure / Guelma Discovery of Khemissa, which contains interesting vestige of the roman era, the visit will continue towards Madaure, the old Numide city, edified as Roman colony, where Saint Augustin studied. Visit of Guelma, a Numide city before it becomes a municipality under Trajan colony and a Roman colony at the end of the III century. From its Roman past, the city maintained the theatre whose scene wall is still in excellent condition. Overnight in Guelma.

Ninth Day: Guelma / Hippo / Annaba

Visit the ancient Roman city of Hippo. The vestiges are scattered among the fig trees, including the Basilica of Peace of St. Augustine. Its archaeological museum houses many sculptures and mosaics. Visit the Basilica of St. Augustine of Hippo overlooking the ruins. Continue the tour to Annaba. Overnight in Annaba.

Tenth Day: Departure Transfer to airport for flight Treasures of Algerian Archeological Heritage



The sand, wind and sun take us to the enchanting sculpture of nature with the life of the flora and fauna where is the luxuriant Oasis strings. The visit of the unwonted city of "El Oued" characterized by the thousand domes, followed by the visit of M'Zab which reflects the spontaneous architecture of the

simple Sahara.

First Day : Algiers

Reception at Algiers airport of Houari Boumedienne. Transfer to package hotel. Dinner and night stay in the hotel.

Second Day: Algiers / Bou-Saada / Biskra In the morning, travel to Bou-Saada through the Gorges of Chiffa which mark the boundary between the northern Mediterranean and highland with steppes that bring the Sahara. In the afternoon, travel to old versera; Biskra. On the way, visit of Chaib valley, representing the past that will bring the visitor of highland with steppes to the Sahara. City walk in Biskra then stay in hotel. Dinner and night stay.

Third Day: Biskra / El-Oued

Excursion to Aures mountains followed by the visit of M'Chouneche palm grove and the balconies of Rouffi. Late in the morning, return to Biskra. Free time in the city center. Travel to El-Oued in the afternoon. On the way, visit of Chott El Melghir. Contemplation of the sunset from the dunes on the road to Nekhla. Dinner and night stay in the hotel.

Fourth Day: El Oued / Touggourt

In the morning, visit of the museum and the city of thousand domes with its picturesque market. In the afternoon, travel to Touggourt, across the sea of sand. On the way, visit of Ghoti, that is a small oasis protected from sand with palms. Excursion to Zaouia Tidjani in Tamalhat. Return to Touggourt by Témacine. Free time in the center of Oued Righ. Stay in hotel, dinner and night stay.

Fifth Day: Touggourt / Ouargla /Ghardaia

In the morning, travel to Ghardaia. Visit of Ouargla and Sahara museum of the old city. Free time in the market of sand roses. Further travel up to Ghardaia. In the afternoon, visit of Ghardaia palm grove palm with its dam and sharing system of raw water from the Oued Zab. Visit the holy city of Beni-Isguen and its market of auction. Stay in hotel, dinner and night stay.

Sixth Day: Ghardaia / Laghouat / Bou-Saada Visit of Ghardaia. Free time and shopping in the town market. Starting around 10 am to Laghouat. On the way, visit of Djelfa and the small village of El-Hamel. Visit of Ferero mill. Late in the afternoon, stay in the hotel of Bou-Saâda. Dinner and night stay.

Seventh Day: Bou-Saada / Algiers

Morning travel to Algiers through Lakhdaria Gorges (previously named Palestro). Visit of Riadh El Feth. In the afternoon, there would be city walk. Free time at the lower Casbah, then transfer to hotel in Algiers. Dinner and night stay in hotel.

Eight Day: Departure

After breakfast, transfer to the airport in Algiers. Assistance is provided in the departure.



First Day : Algiers

Arrival at Algiers airport Houari Boumediene. Transfer to the package hotel. Check in, dinner and overnight stay.

Second Day: Algiers / Bou-Saada / Laghouat In the Morning departure for Bou-Saada, passing through the gorges of Chiffa that mark the border between northern Mediterranean and highland steppe announcing the Sahara. Visit of El Hamel Mill and Ferrero. Breakfast at hotel. In the afternoon continue the tour in Laghouat. Check in at the hotel(half board) orientation tour and visit the Marabout of Sidi Abdelkader. Sunset contemplation.

Third Day: Laghouat / Ain Sefra

After breakfast, early morning departure for the longest step of the circuit (near 450kms). Across over the vast highland steppe. Passage through Aflou and El-Bayadh. Cold meals will be offered during the tour. Local visits to Ain El-Ouarka with the discovery of rock carvings of Tiout. Late afternoon Arrival to Ain Sefra. Check in at your hotel, dinner and overnight.

Fourth Day: Ain Sefra / Taghit / Beni-Abbes After breakfast, departure to Bechar. City tour by bus and continue the tour to Taghit. Breakfast at the hotel. Relaxation. Visit the Oasis and rock carvings of Taghit. And continue the visit to Beni-Abbes. Check at your hotel, dinner and overnight stay.

Fifth Day: Beni-Abbes / Timimoun

After breakfast, visit the first hermitage of father Foucault, the oasis, the old Ksar and the museum of Sahara of Beni-Abbes. Lunch at the hotel. In the afternoon, departure to Timimoun. Stop at the Kerzaz oasis with its famous pendulum wells; continue the tour to Timimoun. Check in at your hotel, dinner and overnight.

Sixth Day: Timimoun / El-Golea

In the morning, walking tour in the palm grove of Timimoun, the large comb in lieu of distribution of water of Fougara and old Ksar . Free time in the center of the city. Lunch at the hotel. In the afternoon, departure to El-Golea. Visit the Zenete fortress at the arrival. Check in at your hotel, dinner and overnight.

Seventh Day: El-Golea / Ghardaïa

After breakfast, visit the tomb of the father Foucault in the small village of Bel-Bachir. Continue the tour to Ghardaia, Check in at the hotel (full board). In the afternoon, visit the palm grove of Ghardaia, the dam and its sharing system of flood waters of Wadi M'Zab. Visit the holy city of Beni-Isguen and its picturesque market at auction.

Eighth Day: Ghardaïa / Laghouat / Bou-Saada After breakfast, visit Ghardaia. Free time for shopping at the Ghardaia market. Departure around 10 am to Laghouat. Lunch at the hotel. In the afternoon, departure to Bou-Saada stopping at Dielfa. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Ninth Day: Bou-Saada / Algiers

Breakfast at hotel and departure to Algiers through the gorges of Lakhdaria (eg Palestro). Visit Riadh El-Feth. Lunch in the center of the city. In the afternoon, city tour. Free time at the old Casbah and transfer to the package hotel, dinner and overnight.

10th Day : Departure

After breakfast, transfer to the airport of Algiers Houari Boumediene. Assistance for Departure

The Saoura peppers the picturesque oasis along the roads of Mauritania. The traveler can choose in the immensity of rolling and ochres dunes of the Great Western erg, the palm groves of the Touat Between each oasis, lies the vastness, the unknown, the strange and magic. No one can hide his emotion, no one can remain indifferent to this eternal silence, this infinite space, a lush oasis and sand sea. Touat and Gourara offer to the viewers one of the most typical architecture of the Sahara.

Firts Day: Algiers

Arrival at Algiers airport Houari Boumediene. Transfer to the package hotel. Check in, dinner and overnight.

Second Day: Algiers / Tamanrasset

Breakfast and early transfer to the airport. Flight to Tamanrasset. Reception and transfer to hotel. Lunch.in Tamanrasset / Assekrem: After lunch, expedition training and departure with the group and the guide (in all terrain vehicles) for a tour in the mysterious and volcanic country of blue men through a trail dotted with rocky cones offering prestigious views in the Atakor massif where we discover the Iharem peak (eg Laperine), the Neolithic tomb "Aderni" in Oued Mezoulit, rock carvings and Gueltas. Late afternoon Arrival at the shelter. Dinner and overnight.

Third Day: Assekrem / Hirafok / Ideles

In the morning after breakfast, departure through the gueltas road to Hirafok Targui village of, a station of rock engravings located in an area where vegetation is abundant. Bivouac in Hirafok. In the afternoon visit the rock engravings and paintings of the region: Assekrem, Oued Zarzoura, Immaara, then continue the tour with the discovery of Oued Irharrar, engravings and paintings on rock panels along the track until Ideles. Arrival at sunset. Camping and dinner.

Forth Day: Ideles / Tazrouk

In the morning after the breakfast, departure to Tazrouk, passing through the Taderaz mountains. Arrival at Tazrouk, famous for the richness of its gardens and its Oasis, the miracle of the strange vegetation that flourishes continually in a wild and wonderful site. Camp for lunch at Oued Azrou. In the afternoon visit the surrounding areas and installation of the camp oriented to Aokasit, one of the finest rock needles of the Hoggar. Camping and dinner.

Fifth Day: Tazrouk / Tahifet / Tamekrest

In the Morning after breakfast, departure to Tahifet passing through Azrou Col, impressive and difficult track, descends and follows the course of Oueds (rivers). Arrival at Tahifet, very tense village, extending in a green valley with varied vegetation. On the way, Camp for lunch. In the afternoon, continue the tour to Tamekrest and installation of the camp at the foot of the waterfall called "Tamekrest" or the Impassable". Dinner and overnight.

Sixth Day: Tamekrest / Tamanrasset

Breakfast at sunrise and departure by 4x4 vehicles through Tamanrasset track. Late morning arrival, check in at the hotel(full board). In the afternoon visit of the red town, capital of Hoggar, Bordj of father Foucault and Targui craft workshops, free entry.

Seventh Day: Tamanrasset / Algiers

Breakfast and transfer to the airport, during the morning. Scheduled flight to Algiers. Arrival at Algiers airport, in the early afternoon, transfer to the package hotel. Dinner and overnight.

Eighth Day: Algiers

Breakfast and transfer to the Algiers airport Houari Boumediene. Assistance for departure



Program:











Arrival at Djanet. Reception and transfer to the city. After noon, training on expedition and travel to Anais in 4x4 vehicle. Crossing of Tassili Ajjer cliffs by Tini rivers and Tiliouine Nado. Bivouac at the river Amais.

Second Day: Amais / Indjaren

After breakfast, travel to the canyons of Indjaren river. Visit of several places of rock paintings and engravings whicle crossing the canyon by its left bank. Restoration and night stay in campsite.

Third Day: Indiaren / Tin-Merzouga

In the morning, starting from Tadrart plateau. You will discover a landscape with sandstone shapes carved by time and having a variety of colored sand dunes, in addition to sandstone and rock castles. Restoration and night stay in campsite.

Fourth Day: Tin-Merzougan / Moul-Ennaga

Further visit up to the regions of Moul-Ennaga containing a lot of mazes. Restoration and night stay in campsite.

Fifth Day: Moul-Ennaga / Alidemma

Departure toward the southwest to exit the Tadrart. Crossing the Imaharatene Tassili of a very special landscape characterized by carved and sculpted blocks of sandstone which are interspersed with wide avenues of blowing sand. Restoration and night stay in the campsite.

Sixth Day: Alidemma / In-Affellahlah

The itinerary of this visiting stage leads to the Erg Admer visit, with a passage in the Mountatins of Tikarkar (eg Mount Gautier). Finally, the visit will take the direction of the northern side, late in the afternoon, to visit Tafassasset river. Restoration and night stay in the campsite.

Seventh Day: In-Affellahlah / Tahort

Crossing part of Erg Admer containing many majestic dunes of utmost importance. Restoration and night stay in the campsite.

Eight Day: Tahort / Djanet

The return to Djanet is by Tegharghart; famous resort containing the famous engraving of the Bovidae (the crying cows), one of the most beautiful rock art in the Tassili. Cross the sandy track of Tahort in Djanet and reaches Djanet in the afternoon. Dinner and night stay in Ajjers inn.

Ninth Day: Djanet

Departure after breakfast and transfer to airport. Assistance is provided in the departure.

With 4X4 vehicle, you will travel among the dunes and assilis and visit the sumptuous places of Tadrart .You will see the natural and Algerian scenery of Libyan Akakus. The return will be via the extreme south of tassili N'Ajjers.

Attendance:

All programs mentioned in this catalog includes reception and assistance ONAT at airports on arrival and departure.

The tour, scheduled and on demand, as well as trips, are supervised by ONAT tour guide.

Accommodation and catering:_

For all tours, except shipments and hiking, the accommodation is provided in hotels selected by ONAT, in a double room with bath, shower and toilet. The board will be as specified in each program in addition to the cost of access (entry fee).

They do not include beverages, services not mentioned in the programs and any other expenses of personal nature.

Transportation:

Depending on the selected program, our tours, expeditions and trips, are made by bus or all conditions types vehicles.

The transport vehicles ONAT are modern and have all the comforts, 4X4 vehicles (Toyota Land Cruiser and Nissan).

Changing:

In case of uncontrolled force majeure (weather, road damage, delay or canceled flights, unforeseeable event ...) or if the number of expected participants is not reached, ONAT reserves the right to cancel or modify all or part of the program.

The costs incurred by any changes will be added into the initially planned prices and subsequently billed.

However, ONAT will endeavor to provide and implement a similar or replacing program, without regard to a change. Any interrupted or cut short program, any included service but not performed by the customer, will not be refunded.

Registration reservation: ___

It is recommended to make reservations well in advance with our sales department (see information and details on last page) and confirm the same within the below limited time, before the arrival of guests:

Expeditions 21 days

These deadlines are advanced by one week for any program scheduled during the periods from December 20th to January 05th and from March 15th to May 15th. The ONAT will provide assistance and support for customers only for programs and services for which he has received and given confirmation and on receiving full payment.

Rate:

They include the reception and assistance, transfers, ground transportation, services provided by the tour guide, moreover meals as specified in each program, in addition to the cost of access (entry fee). They do not include beverages, services not mentioned in the programs and any other expenses of personal nature. In case of price change occurring in the included services in our programs (hotels, restaurants, transportation, etc...), our rates will be adjusted and charged accordingly.

The regulations must take place as follows:

The payment will be made by check or wire transfer for ONAT confirmed price convertible currency value.

Vehicles:

Land Rover of 7-seater but being used by 4 passengers + 1 driver.

Accommodation:

Outside of Tamanrasset and Djanet where accommodation is provided in hotels during expeditions and tours, in addition to that nights are spent in the followings:

- In the Hoggar, in local shelters or huts.
- In Tassili, in tent and bivouac.

As a rough guide, the temperature can reach 0° at night and 20/25° in the day.

The provided tents are of recent type that is scout (2 seats), Single or family tent (2/4 places).

It is also provided a foam mattress and woolen blankets.

The sleeping bags are not provided and must be brought by participants.

Meals:

(Outside of Tamanrasset and Djanet) Breakfast: coffee, tea or milk with bread and jam.

Lunch:

Starter, cold meat and vegetables, dessert.

Dinner:

Starter, hot garnished dish, dessert. No drink is provided, only water. Participants can take drinks from Djanet and Tamanrasset.

Drugs:

All tours and expeditions are equipped with an emergency medical kit.

Luggage:

We only accept canvas bags (camping or marine type).

Personal Equipment:

the participants should bring to the circuits the followings:

Sleeping bag and down jacket for the night. Mountain shoes, woollens, Flashlight with batteries, electric shaver batteries, trousers for ladies are essential, Light clothes, Refreshing towels, Kleenex, lip creams and face Straw hat or cloth, sunglasses, movies (video, photo), Tobacco.
